Food Aid

A big part of Manna on Main Street's outreach is providing food to people in need. Highlights of food aid from 2009 include:

- 22,000+ meals served
- 495 households were assisted by our food pantry
- 80 tons of food distributed

Soup Kitchen



Delicious soups, casseroles and sandwiches are offered seven days a week by caring volunteers.

Food Cupboard



Last year 495 households came for food. In addition to the 75 tons of food distributed to clients, another 10 tons were given to local churches and food pantries.

Community Dinners



Evenings, weekends and holidays are busy times at Manna. Scouts, youth groups, families, business teams and various social organizations hosted 113 meals last year.

Financial Aid

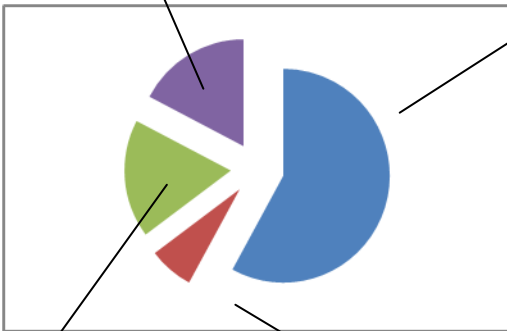
Manna on Main Street provides financial aid when individuals or families have an emergency. We carefully screen individuals and send payments directly to the landlord, utility company or organization that provides the needed service.



Working adults and elderly rely upon Manna for help with medical aid. Last year \$5,237 in prescriptions and medical assistance was given.



When financial emergencies arise, Manna is there to help. Last year we gave \$20,187 in rental aid.



Families and older adults often need help with heating oil and electric bills. Last year we spent \$13,726.

The need for emergency shelter is a constant. For the homeless we provided 36 nights of emergency motel stays for \$1,974.



Youth

Young people are a vital part of Manna's outreach and work in the community. Youth from the North Penn area and neighboring towns help by stocking shelves, serving soup and cooking meals.

In addition to serving, youth of all ages benefit from Manna's programs for school supplies, book bags and gifts for the holidays.

Cooking for Teens



Three days a week, for nine weeks, local teens cooked nutritious meals during the summer.



Healthy Snacks

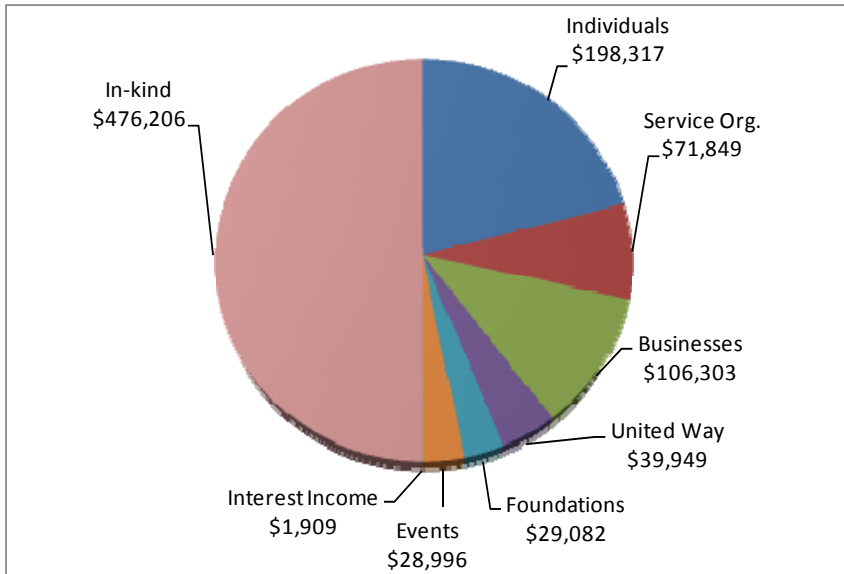
The North Penn Boys & Girls Club has an After School Homework Program. Manna on Main Street provides 200 healthy snacks each school day for the children who participate in the program.

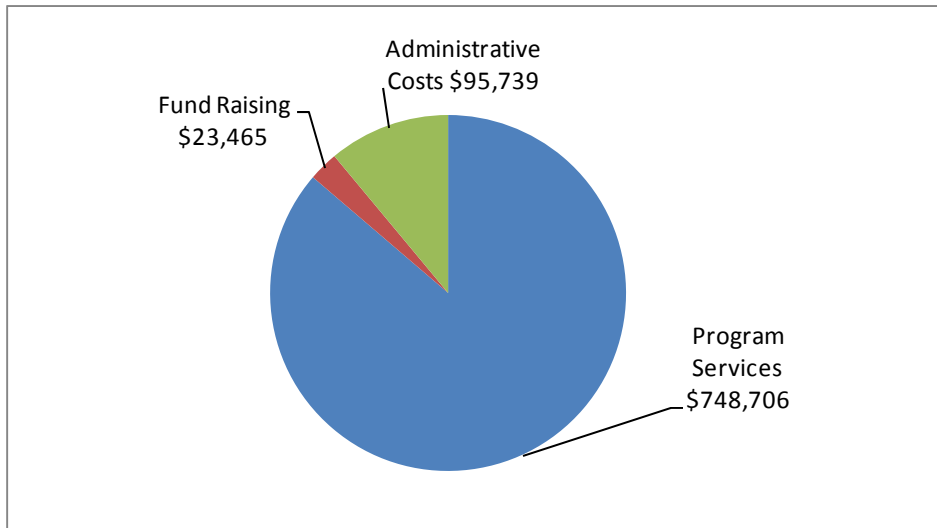
